➤ HIGH MOUNTAIN PASSES

1. KHardung LA: PREVIOUS HIGHEST MOTORABLE PASS 17,582 FT. (5,359 M.)
2. TSAGA LA: 17400 FT. (5,300 M.)
3. NURBU LA: 17,328 FT. (4,976 M.)
4. UMLING LA: WORLD'S HIGHEST MOTORABLE PASS 19,300 FT. (5,882 M.)
5. PHOTI LA: 18,124 FT. (5,524 M.)

➤ **LEH LOCAL SIGHTSEEING:** INCLUDES ICONIC ATTRACTIONS LIKE HALL OF FAME, SHANTI STUPA, LEH PALACE, AND THE BUSTLING LEH MARKET. VISITORS CAN EXPLORE THE HISTORIC THIKSEY MONASTERIES, MARVEL AT THE ARCHITECTURE OF SHEY PALACE, AND VISIT MAGNETIC HILL, WHERE VEHICLES APPEAR TO DEFY GRAVITY. THE CONFLUENCE OF THE INDUS AND ZANSKAR RIVERS IS ANOTHER MUST-VISIT SPOT.

➤ **TURTUK VILLAGE:** A PICTURESQUE VILLAGE IN LADAKH, INDIA, NEAR THE INDIA-PAKISTAN BORDER, KNOWN FOR ITS STUNNING LANDSCAPES, BALTI CULTURE, AND APRICOT ORCHARDS.

➤ **HUNDER:** LOCATED IN LADAKH'S NUBRA VALLEY, IS FAMOUS FOR ITS STUNNING SAND DUNES, DOUBLE-HUMPED BACTRIAN CAMELS, AND SCENIC DESERT LANDSCAPE SURROUNDED BY SNOW-CAPPED MOUNTAINS.

➤ **PANGONG LAKE:** THE WORLD'S HIGHEST SALTWATER LAKE WITH PRISTINE BLUE WATERS THAT CHANGE SHADES THROUGHOUT THE DAY.

➤ **THE STARGAZERS' PARADISE AND HOME TO THE ASIA'S LARGEST AND WORLD'S HIGHEST ASTRONOMICAL OBSERVATORY: HANLE**

- After breakfast, receive your bike for the expedition.
- Explore Leh city with local sightseeing:
- Hall of Fame (a museum dedicated to Indian Army soldiers).
- Thiksey Monastery (a beautiful Tibetan monastery).
- Sindhu Ghat (a serene riverside spot).
- Shey Palace (former royal residence).
- Shanti Stupa (offering panoramic views of Leh).
- Leh Market (for local shopping and souvenirs).
- Overnight stay in Leh.

TURTUK



LEH TO TURTUK VIA KHARDUNG LA PASS

- After breakfast, begin the ride to Turtuk Village.
- En route, visit:
 - Khardung La Pass 17,582 ft. / 5359 M (one of the world's highest motorable roads).
 - Nubra Valley, known for its scenic beauty.
- Reach Turtuk, the last Indian village near the Indo-Pak border, home to the Balti community.
- Explore Turtuk's culture, landscapes, and apricot orchards.
- Overnight stay in Turtuk (tents).

TURTUK TO HUNDER (NUBRA VALLEY)

- Morning: Enjoy a guided village tour of Turtuk, exploring its rich Balti culture.
- Interact with Balti locals and visit the Traditional Balti Museum.
- Afternoon: After lunch, ride back to Hunder (Nubra Valley).
- Evening: Visit the sand dunes and enjoy a double-humped Bactrian camel ride.
- Overnight stay in Hunder.

HUNDER TO PANGONG LAKE

- Morning: After breakfast, visit the Maitreya Buddha Statue (132 ft) in Diskit Monastery.
- Ride towards Pangong Lake via the scenic Shyok Village route.
- Afternoon: Reach Pangong Lake (14,270 ft), the world's highest saltwater lake.
- Enjoy photography and breathtaking views of the stunning blue waters.
- Overnight stay in tents at Pangong (or nearby).

PANGONG TO HANLE

- After breakfast, proceed towards Hanle.
- Enroute visit:
 - Rezag La / Chushul War Memorial, built in memory of the brave soldiers of the 13 Kumaon Regiment from the 1962 Indo-China War.
 - Tsaga La Pass, offering stunning landscapes.
- Afternoon: Reach Hanle, home to:
 - 17th-century Hanle Monastery, belonging to the Tibetan Drukpa Kagyu sect.
 - Indian Astronomical Observatory, one of the world's highest observatories.
- Overnight stay in Hanle (basic guest house).

HANLE UMLINGLA HANLE

- Start the day with a hearty breakfast before embarking on an adventurous ride to Umling La Pass (19,300 ft.), the highest motorable road in the world.
- The journey passes through:
 - Narbula Pass (17,328 ft.) – offering mesmerizing landscapes.
 - Photi La Pass (18,124 ft.) – another scenic high-altitude pass.
- Return to Hanle and unwind in its tranquil surroundings.
- Visit Hanle Gompa, a historic Buddhist monastery.
- If access is granted, explore the Indian Astronomical Observatory, one of the world's highest research facilities.
- Overnight stay in Hanle (basic guest house).

NOTE FOR RENTED BIKES:

- A REFUNDABLE AMOUNT OF INR 10,000/- (CASH) IS TO BE DEPOSITED AND SHALL BE REFUNDED AFTER CHECKING FOR DAMAGES TO THE BIKE AFTER THE TOUR
- RIDER / PILLION RIDER SHOULD CARRY OWN HELMET & RIDING GEARS.

- **ACCOMMODATION ON SINGLE SHARING: €2110 Per Person**

TERMS & CONDITIONS

- Sequence of the day-wise itinerary, tour program may change depending upon road conditions/traffic schedules/restrictions or other unforeseen conditions.
- Itinerary can change due to landslides, weather conditions, road conditions or any unavoidable circumstances beyond our control; we shall not be responsible for it. The additional cost incurred will be in addition to the package cost.
- Only one backpacks or rucksack of 60-70 liters is allowed.
- Riders should carry own helmets and riding gears (for owned as well as rental bike).
- All participants should carry any original ID-proofs like International Driving license, Passport
- We highly recommend high altitude travel insurance for tour period.

PAYMENT TERM:

- ADVANCE OF € 800 PER HEAD SHALL BE BOOKING AMOUNT IMMEDIATELY (BOOKINGS SHALL BE CONFIRMED ONLY AFTER RECEIVING ADVANCE)
- FULL PAYMENT SHALL BE PAID BEFORE 60 DAYS OF THE TOUR
- € 300 NON REFUNDABLE WILL BE CHARGED AND BALANCE WILL BE REFUNDED FOR CANCELLATION OF BOOKING, AFTER PAYMENT OF ADVANCE
- A 50% CANCELLATION CHARGES OF THE TOTAL PACKAGE AMOUNT WILL BE CHARGED AND BALANCE WILL BE REFUNDED IF THE CLIENT CANCELS BOOKING BEFORE 45 DAYS OF THE COMMENCEMENT DATE OF TOUR
